SPECIAL OPPORTUNITIES

1. The Lakeside Club is offering its Club members the opportunity to dress a table for the Fall Tea. One of our exhibitors expressed interest in dressing a table as well. Therefore, we thought we would open it up to all our exhibitors.

We need a table set for tea for eight people from the tablecloth to the teapot. This includes tablecloth, one teapot, silverware, dishes, teacups with saucers, (not mugs) and centerpiece or anything else you might add to your tablescape. Tables need to be dressed Friday November 17 by 6:00 p.m. The round table is 60 inches.

2. On Sunday, November 18, in order to increase attendance at the Sunday Exhibition, we would encourage you to provide a hands-on "crafty" demonstration at one of our 15 round tables. You could recruit "students" for a fee (that you would keep) to attend, or just do a demonstration. Fees might include charges for materials, etc. Classes could be 1 or up to 3 hours long. This activity would be totally up to you.

FAQS

What size tables are available? Each exhibitor will have access to one 8 foot rectangular table and two chairs.

Is there a charge to exhibit? Yes. \$10 per table.

When is set up? Set up is planned from noon to 6:00 p.m. on Friday, November 17, and/or Saturday 8 to 9:30 a.m.

When is break down? Break down is planned to take place immediately following the Sunday, November 19 Exhibition Hours. So break down will be from 4- 6 pm.

Do I need my own cash box? Yes. Each exhibitor is responsible for all that goes on at that their table. If you are offering sales of your art, you are responsible for all sales, whether cash, check, or credit card and then securing any payments. The Lakeside Club and the RRCA will not be able to sell on your behalf, nor would they be able to protect your cash box.

What about Security? The building will be locked when the Exhibition is not open to the public. When open to the public, Lakeside Club members will perambulate the premises. However, the Ramsdell Regional Center for the Arts will not be held liable for any lost, damaged or stolen items. The Lakeside Club has purchased additional insurance coverage for the protection of your property while at the Ramsdell Regional Center for the Arts.

When should I be at my table? You can choose not to staff your table, but we suggest someone be there when the public is. Saturday 10-12:30 p.m. and 1-4 p.m. Sunday 1-4 p.m.

Can I attend the Tea? Of course you can. Just purchase a ticket from any Lakeside Club member for \$15.00.
